- O OFFICIAL TOEFL or IELTS (waived if attending a U.S. high school for 3 years)
  - TOEFL score of 61 iBT required. Request scores to be sent to code 0236
  - IELTS score of 6.0 required. Email results to <u>international@csuci.edu</u> or mail a copy (score will be verified online with IELTS)
