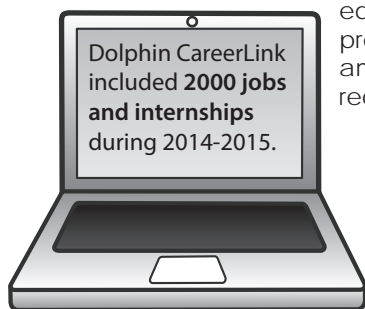

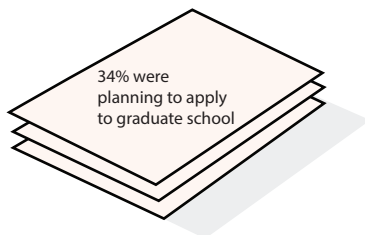


education represented the most predominant industries hiring among employers who recruit at CI.

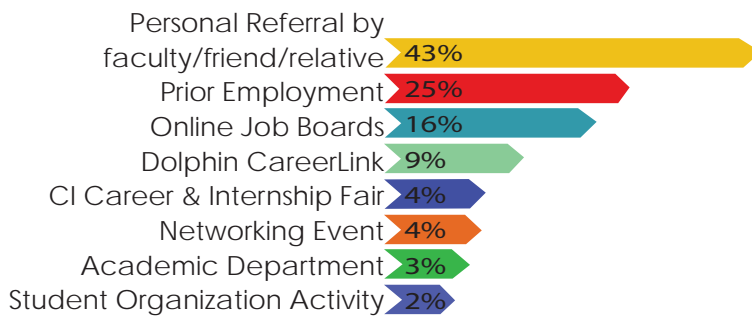


GRADUATE SCHOOL

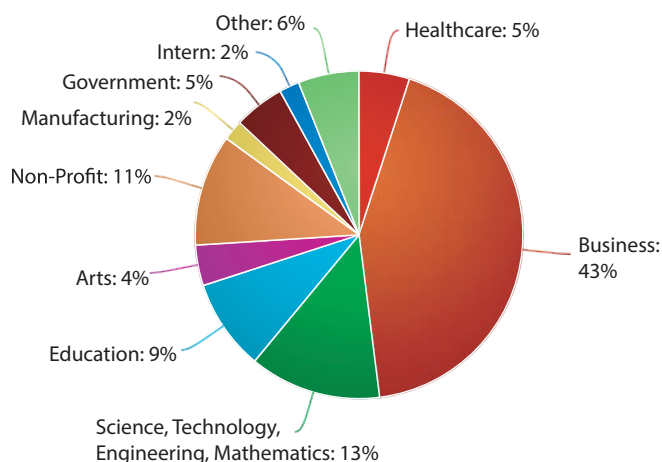
The majority of respondents who were admitted to graduate school were graduates of academic programs including education, social sciences, and humanities/fine arts.
