Brief Activity Description	2 years ago Christophe Bourelly and Matt Fumanski took a group of students to the Research Station on Santa rosa Island to record and create woks of art, photo, video, painting, drawing,temporary environmental sculpture around the theme of human impact on our natural environment. The endeavor was a success, and the current generation of CI students enrolled in the Art Program are interested in revisiting the island and having there own experience making wok along the same creative lines. This trip would afford a mew generation of CI students the same opportunity and experience.
Learning Outcomes and Relation to IRA to Course Offerings	The activity directly relates to both sculpture and painting students, as well as art students in general, in regards to their further understanding of art making as it relates to composition, form and content. The field trip also integrates aspects of social art making, that is art that carries a specific goal of communicating through visual means, issues that are of importance to us as a human community. The art work created will confront the viewer with questions about our environment, our place in that environment, and our responsibility as stewards of that environment, specific to the Nation Park and Santa Rosa Island, as well as our coastline.
