

## Formation Decision Guide – Committee vs. Task Force vs. Working Group Cal State Channel Islands

This guide helps determine the most appropriate structure when initiating a new effort. Not every issue requires a standing committee. Consider purpose, scope, and duration.

## **Definitions**

- Standing Committee: Ongoing body with formal charge and long-term responsibility.
- **Task Force**: Temporary group focused on solving a specific issue within a set timeframe.
- Working Group: Flexible, operational team focused on execution or process improvement.
