

It became clear early on that it was prudent to delay the launch of this initiative to allow for other committees and taskforces to make progress on their outcomes and then design the program to be actionable towards advancing those outcomes. Additionally, there was concern about the bandwidth of the numerous faculty, staff, and administrators already committed to multiple year-long working groups.
