## Summary:

One-time funding.

The Center for Community Engagement (CCE) currently administers the community service portion of the Federal Work Study program (7% of FWS funds must go towards students working in the community). As a result, the CCE has created the community service initiative, CSUCI Corps program, a collaboration with the Federal Work Study program and CCE community partners.

The program advances community service for approximately 10-15 student leaders, who receive FWS funds, by providing them with community service work at area non-profits or schools to meet community needs in tutoring and literacy development. The CCE is requesting funding to build out this program to include a STEM arm of the initiative. CSUCI-STEM Corps would be a tutoring and enrichment program focused on supporting elementary and middle (K-6) student learning in math and science.
