## ISOLATION & QUARANTINE REQUIREMENTS CSUCI STUDENTS, FACULTY, and STAFF

#### Persons Who Test Positive for COVID-19

# Everyone, regardless of vaccination status, previous infection or lack of symptoms.

#### **Action: (Isolation)**

- Stay home (PDF) for at least 5 days.
- Isolation can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present or are resolving and a diagnostic specimen\* collected on day 5 or later tests negative. Testing-out must be arranged through EHS
- If unable to test or choosing not to test, and symptoms are not present or are resolving, isolation can end after day 10.
- If fever is present, isolation should be continued until fever resolves.
- If symptoms, other than fever, are not resolving continue to isolate until symptoms are resolving or until after day 10.
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings (see Section below on masking for additional information)

### Persons Who are Exposed to Someone with COVID-19

#### **Unvaccinated**; OR

Vaccinated and booster-eligible but have **NOT** yet received their booster dose.

(Refer to CDC COVID-19 Booster Shots to determine who is booster eligible

#### **Action: (Quarantine)**

- **Stay home** (PDF) for at least 5 days, after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19.
- Test on day 5. Testing-out must be arranged through EHS
- Quarantine can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present and a diagnostic specimen collected on day 5 or later tests negative.
- If unable to test or choosing not to test, and symptoms are not present, quarantine can end after day 10.
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings (see Section below on masking for additional information).
- Strongly encouraged to get vaccinated or boosted.
- If testing positive, follow isolation recommendations above.
- If symptoms develop, test and stay home.

#### Persons Who are Exposed to Someone with COVID-19

## Boosted; OR Vaccinated, but not yet booster-eligible

(Refer to CDC COVID-19 Booster Shots to determine who is booster eligible

#### **Action: (NO Quarantine)**

- Test on day 5.
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days, especially in indoor settings (see Section below on masking for additional information)
- If testing positive, follow isolation recommendations above.
- If symptoms develop, test and stay home.
