Why have an Emergency Operations Plan?

- To address risks and responses to them
- To establish authorities and organizational relationships
- To assign responsibilities
- To provide a guide to respond quicker and more effectively
- To ensure response actions are consistent with other agencies





Your Role as a Disaster Service Worker: In an emergency, Public Employees Roll Up Their Sleeves

Any public employees performing duties as a Disaster Service Worker are acting within the scope of disaster service duties by assisting any unit of the organization or performing any act or work contributing to the protection of life or property and to mitigate the affects of an emergency.
