

Advanced Placement (AP) Credit 2022 – 2023

(Effective August 1, 2022 to July 31, 2023)

Credit is granted for external examinations in accordance with [CSU Executive Order 1036](#). AP exams passed with scores of 3 or higher will earn a grade of credit (CR) and will not be calculated into students' grade point averages (GPAs). Credit granted is reviewed annually and occasionally varies from exam year to exam year, as content, exams, and Channel Islands (CI) curricula are subject to change. Thus, CI credit is awarded based on exam completion date.
