Minutes of Meeting *Hearing*
April 10, 2000

A public hearing on the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) was held on Monday, April 10, 2000, at 1:45 p.m. The meeting was held in Lecture Hall 2, California State University, Channel Islands, One University Drive, Camarillo. Mr. Art Flores, the delegated agent for the Site Authority, chaired the meeting.

Staff present were: Art Flores, Steve Svete, Tony Valenzuela, George Dutra

Mr. Flores explained the purpose of this public meeting, which was to review and hear comments pertaining to the draft SEIR for the California State University, Channel Islands Revised Campus Master Plan, 15,000 FTES. The draft SEIR addresses issues and notable changes from the original plan. The 45-day public review and comment period opened March 23, 2000, and closes May 8, 2000.

Mr. Flores opened the Public Comment Period. Mr. Henry Graumlich, Resource Manager, Camrosa Water District, read and submitted a letter of comments and concerns pertaining to negotiations and urged that agreements pertaining to water and wastewater services to the university site be finalized.

Mr. Flores called for any other comments and, hearing none, closed the Public Comment Period of the California State University, Channel Islands Site Authority SEIR public hearing.

The hearing was adjourned at 1:55 p.m.
