
Self Care Affinity Group:

RETURNING TO WORK SOON? HERE ARE SOME WAYS TO MAKE THE PROCESS EASIER


NERVES - ANTICIPATION - TRANSITION

It's not weird to feel apprehensive about returning to work. According to psychologist Dr. Albers, it's normal considering we've been safe in our homes for so long. If you're worried, what you're experiencing is called "reentry anxiety" and there are two forms of it: "The first form concerns safety. People are anxious that when they leave their house, they may unknowingly contract COVID-19 or possibly spread it. The second type is around social interactions. Over the past year, we have been social distancing and lost practice of how to meet with people in person, look them in the eyes and engage in everyday chitchat."

Suggestions:

"Don't jump right in. Put your toe in the water. Go back to your office before your official start date. Look around. Sit in your chair. Remember that a lot has changed in a year, so expect that things are not going to look or feel like they did a year ago."
