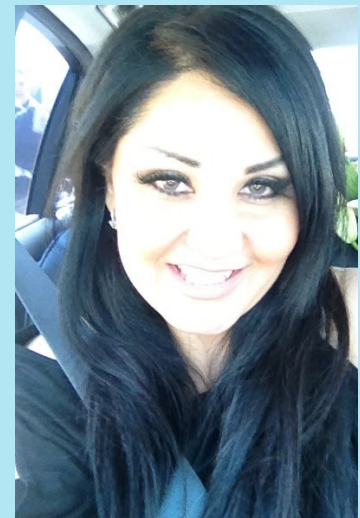

Former CSUCI Articulation Officer and Lead Curriculum Analyst, **Janet Rizzoli**, who retired in December 2020 was honored with the California Intersegmental Articulation Council's (CIAC's) 2021 Service Award for her service to students and to California's articulation community. 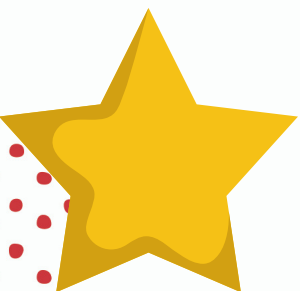
