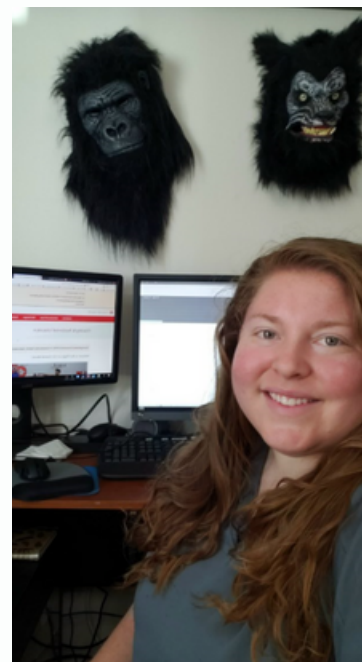
"She is one of those people in a complicated job. She is for the most part hidden from view, yet most professors couldn't do their job without her."
