

Scenarios	Steps Employees Should Take	Ways Supervisors Can Support
<p>Isolation</p> <p><i>When?</i> Following a positive COVID-19 test result</p> <p><i>Who?</i> Anyone regardless of vaccination status</p>	<p>Report positive case to Environmental Health & Safety</p> <p>Stay home for at least 5-10 days depending on assessment by Environmental Health & Safety; must document negative test to return between days 5 & 10</p> <p>May be extended beyond 10 days if symptoms persist</p> <p>Cannot return to campus without clearance of Environmental Health & Safety and submission of Release of Isolation (ROI) form</p>	<p>If a supervisor is aware that an employee is feeling ill or has been told by an employee about a positive test result or exposure:</p> <p>Inform employee they should return home immediately after a positive test result or if symptomatic</p> <p>Inform employee to access free testing at Petit Salon following an exposure (Monday to Wednesday, 9 am – 3 pm; Thursday & Friday, 9 am – 12 pm)</p>
<p>Symptomatic without a Positive Test Result</p> <p><i>When?</i> If symptoms of COVID-19 develop</p> <p><i>Who?</i> Anyone regardless of vaccination status</p>	<p>Leave immediately if symptoms develop on campus</p> <p>Test as soon as possible</p> <p>Do not return to campus until symptoms resolve</p> <p>Test again if symptoms persist over multiple days</p> <p>Isolate if test positive at any point</p>	<p>Encourage the employee to file a report with Environmental Health & Safety</p> <p>Complete a report to Environmental Health & Safety yourself</p> <p>Inform the employee that they can contact Environmental Health & Safety at 805-437-3550 with questions</p>
<p>Exposure</p> <p><i>When?</i> If you have been within the same indoor airspace as someone who tested positive for 15+ minutes</p> <p><i>Who?</i> Anyone regardless of vaccination status</p>	<p>Monitor for symptoms and wear a mask indoors and around others for 10 days following exposure</p> <p>Test as soon as possible and again 3 to 5 days after the exposure</p> <p>Test again if symptoms develop; do not return to campus until symptoms resolve even if testing negative</p> <p>Isolate if test positive at any point</p>
