

This is your opportunity to nominate your teammates from the Division of Business & Financial Affairs (BFA) who have performed over and above their day-to-day duties for a recognition award to be presented at the upcoming Fall Division Meeting. Nominations of BFA staff are also welcomed from outside of the division.



The three division awards for which an employee may be recognized are described as follows:

Excellence Award: Recognizes BFA staff members who demonstrate excellence in their service to the University. Through their exemplary professionalism and achievements, they have supported their colleagues in advancing the University's mission and goals.

Efficiency Award: Recognizes BFA staff members who demonstrate skill in finding, recommending, promoting, or executing the betterment of processes for a department, division, or the University. Through their exemplary efforts and achievements, they have supported their colleagues in advancing the mission and goals of the University through efficiency.

Collaboration/Teamwork Award: Recognizes an individual, team, or department within or outside of BFA* who demonstrates team-oriented cooperation to complete a significant project or achieve a goal. They delivered a significant benefit or value to a department, division, or the University. (*Nominations for an individual, team, or department outside of the BFA division must be originated by a BFA employee.)

The nomination period for BFA awards begins **October 25, 2021**, and ends **November 14, 2021**. The awards will be presented at the **Fall BFA Division Meeting on Dec 1, 2021**.



FEATURED RECIPE AEBLESKIVERS

ingredients:

- 2 CUPS BUTTERMILK
- 2 CUPS FLOUR
- 3 EGGS,
SEPARATED
- 1 TSP BAKING
POWDER
- 1 TSP BAKING SODA
- 1/2 TSP SALT
- 2 TB SUGAR
- 1/4 CUP MELTED
BUTTER

steps:

MIX BUTTERMILK, FLOUR, EGG YOLKS, BAKING POWDER, SALT, BAKING SODA, AND SUGAR IN LARGE BOWL UNTIL WELL COMBINED. IN A SEPARATE BOWL, BEAT THE EGG WHITES UNTIL STIFF PEAKS FORM. FOLD THE EGG WHITES INTO THE BATTER UNTIL JUST COMBINED. HEAT AEBLESKIVER PAN OVER MEDIUM-HIGH HEAT. BRUSH WITH CANOLA OR VEGETABLE OIL. ONCE HEATED, FILL CUPS TO JUST BELOW THE TOP WITH BATTER AND LET COOK UNTIL GOLDEN BROWN. YOU WILL NEED TO USE A SKEWER OR KEBAB STICK TO TURN THE AEBLESKIVERS AS THEY COOK TO ENSURE EVEN HEATING. SERVE WITH MELTED BUTTER AND CINNAMON SUGAR; JAM/PRESERVES; ICE CREAM OR WHATEVER TOPPING YOU PREFER. :) ENJOY!


