What is DUO?

DUO is a second layer of protection that verifies you're really you. Even if attackers know your ID or password, DUO, which is a second factor of authentication, stops them.



Why DUO for CI?

60% of incidents happen because of compromised passwords*

DUO will help us by adding a second layer of protection to

- ✓ Protect our faculty, students, and staff's online identities
- ✓ Provide a way to know if someone is attempting to use your CSUCI credentials
- ✓ Protect the reputation of our University

Benefits of DUO

- Easy to distribute (no pick-up except for hardware tokens)
- Self-service options for users
- Easy to use
- Multiple authentication methods supported
- Works on multiple devices



Risks

Possible risks for DUO implementation

- Unavailability of services behind myCI
- Students or employees are locked out of their account because they misplaced their phone
- Students or employees are locked out of their account because they lose their hardware token

Initial project phase (faculty and staff)

- Some important milestones
 - 04/2018 - Proof of Concept
 - 06/2018 - Pilot-1
 - 09/2018 - Pilot-2
 - 12/2018 - Pilot-3
 - 03/2019 - Initial CI Financials Group
 - 08/2019 - Initial VPN User's Group

Status

- 180 staff and faculty members have DUO.

Plan

- Complete phase I by 12/21/2019.



DUO Phase II proposal

DUO phase II is to extended DUO security for Students at CI.

Total funding requested \$36,000

Site license \$26,000 (for 3 years)
Equipment (tokens) \$7,000
Communication and Workshops \$3,000 (one-time cost)
