a. DISCUSSION ITEM: A Resolution Urging the Office of the President to Take Initiative in Developing an NCAA Sports Program as Part of the CI 2030+ Vision (B. Davis)

i. Corrections were given to a couple parts

1. ASI should be changed to ASI Student Government

2. Changed the timeline from the end of the 2025 academic year to the end of the Fall 2025 semester

b. DISCUSSION ITEM: A Resolution Calling for Meal Plan Flexibility and Student Autonomy (N. Soriano)

i. Senator Soriano provides the Senate with proof that this is done at other colleges, and gives an example from the University of Florida

ii. Senator Henriksen: Believes that there should be something about cooking and cleaning up after yourself in the dorm kitchens

iii. VP Harris: Asks for the reasoning behind distributing the resolution to so many other parties

iv. Senator Soriano: Explains that it could become an example for other campuses

c. DISCUSSION ITEM: Time Place Manner Policy (B. Davis)

i. Senator Davis: Encourages the executive members to ask Dr Yoa to send a reminder email on the Time Place Manner policy

ii. VP Harris: Asks Senator Davis to send an email with more background information

iii. Senator Henriksen: Also believes we need more information about the Time Place Manner policy

iv. Director Marcolino: Explains that the demonstration is in Central Mall today at 3pm

v. Senator Davis: Explains that many students who are apart of the black student union and SQE and that a female black student who was utilizing a blow horn was approached by police
