b. DISCUSSION ITEM: Campus Dining Meeting (N. Soriano)

- i. Senator Soriano: Explains that he felt as though the meeting with campus dining services was unproductive and many of his questions went unanswered
- ii. Senator Soriano: Asks the senate for feedback on what are the possible next steps
- iii. Senator Henriksen: Says she was discussing with people that they like that they don't have to cook meals for themselves
- iv. Senator Henriksen: Says she personally enjoys the café because she gets to see people she wouldn't normally see, and she feels like they have a good variety of fruits and vegetables
- v. Senator Soriano: Feels like people shouldn't be forced to have a meal plan because everyone has a different experience
- vi. Senator Fox left at 11:00 am
- vii. President Fox: Explains that this was a CSU wide issue as he heard many discussions about it at CSSA, explains he is in support of expanding the exemption opportunity to not make it as hard to get
- viii. President Fox: Wants to make sure the students have a plan on how they will feed themselves if not at the café, just to make sure students have food security throughout the year
- ix. Vice President Harris: Says that during the meeting it was discussed that students should know how to budget and find nutritional food
- x. President Fox: Agrees with VP Harris and says that the materials and resources should not be mandated but they should be available for the students who choose to opt out
- xi. President Fox: Says that we need to provide options for the campus dining partners because senate can't ask them to change something and then not give them possible solutions
- xii. Senator Henriksen: Asks if Senator Soriano if he uses the communal kitchens, explains that the communal kitchens are not well kept as the students don't tend to clean up after themselves.
- xiii. Senator Davis yields time to Advisor Block-Weiss
- xiv. Advisor Block-Weiss: Tells the senate that if a resolution is drafted, we have a very small amount of time to get the resolution passed
- xv. Advisor Block-Weiss: Tells the senate that they should do more research and see if they can find evidence of another school that gives a general opt out and add it into the resolution

- xvi. President Fox: Says that maybe adding a sign-up sheet in the dorms to give people a more organized time and way of cooking
