1. *What did your team commit to completing during this month? (What did you promise?)*
 - a. The Student Success Partnership (SSP) committed to advising interventions for students with more than 60 units.
 - b. The SSP committed to providing easily available and understandable resources at the program level.
 - c. The SSP committed to linking academically at-risk students to their academic programs.
 - d. The SSP committed to a campus-wide "Student Success Week."
 - e. The campus finalized efforts to implement Early Start.
2. *What did you do and how will it help?*
 - a. Names of all undeclared students were provided to Advising for personal follow-up. This action will reduce the number of undeclared upper-division students and connect them to a faculty advisor.
 - b. Task Force 3 on Roadmaps (Do they exist? Where are they? Are they helpful) was convened. Findings of the task force will help inform processes for declaration of major (see 1b above).
 - c. Academic program chairs were provided an Early Warning students list (currently enrolled CI students with GPAs of 2.0 - 2.2). Some chairs have contacted at-risk majors in their program.
 - d. Task Force 4 on Early Warning students (currently enrolled CI students with GPAs of 2.0 - 2.2) was convened to collect stories behind the data. Findings of the task force will help the campus learn more about these students and how they should be helped.
 - e. The SSP Steering Committee met on March 6 to discuss the Student Success Week planned for October 2012 and to discuss next steps.
 - f. Early Start registration/payment dates for English and Math were finalized, along with dates of offerings for both programs. The website has been updated with this information.
3. *What will you accomplish next month?*
 - a. The Student Success Partnership Steering Committee will meet on April 3 to finalize the goals and themes surrounding Student Success Week.
 - b. Jane Sweetland and Terry Ballman will give a presentation on the Student Success Partnership at the April 17 meeting of Academic.
 - c. Results of Task Force 3 and Task Force 4 will be discussed, and next steps identified.
 - d. Continuing development of communication to assist faculty in earlier intervention for students.
