Title IX Alternative Resolution Process – 60 Business Days*

*The informal resolution process can begin at any time before a determination of responsibility is reached and generally concludes no later than 60 Working Days after both Parties provide voluntary, written consent to participate. The Parties and the Title IX Coordinator / DHR Administrator may agree to one or more extensions of the 60 Working Day deadline, which will be confirmed in writing. The timeline of the formal complaint resolution process will be paused during the facilitation of any informal resolution process and will resume if an agreement cannot be reached.
