Software: At CI, we have two video editing software available in computers that are free for students to use. Computers in Broome library reading room and the Writing & Multiliteracy Center are installed with Camtasia and Premier Pro CC (Adobe). **For most basic editing purposes, Camtasia might be best for students who don't need to create professional level editing of their film.** Camtasia is also very easy to learn, with drag and drop features for importing media and applying animation and transitions.
